


Replicas of rare bird book donated by Hagen auctioned for record-breaking amount at this year's AFA Convention

Books raise \$2500 U.S. for Avian Aviculture

MONTREAL, Canada – August 21, 2013 – A rare book about parrots, written by the late Dr Anton Reichenow, made a huge impact at the American Federation of Aviculture's recent convention, as two authentic replicas of the book were auctioned off for a record \$1250 U.S. each.

The genuine replicas, which were donated to the AFA by Rolf C Hagen Inc., are faithful reproductions of Dr Reichenow's 135-year-old illustrated book covering a variety parrot species.

First published in 1878, the extremely rare tome includes 33 hand-drawn family portraits of a variety of parrot species-including Mealy Amazons, Guatemalan Amazons, Vinaceous Amazons, White-fronted Amazons, Green-cheeked Amazons, and Yellow-cheeked Amazons. The detailed colour renditions were drawn by wildlife artist Gustav Mützel (1839 -1893).





Dr Reichenow (1847-1941) was a German zoologist and ornithologist who specialized in African birds. He made major contributions to ornithology during a very active 50-year career, travelling extensively to exotic places and discovering many new species. He has seven bird species named after him.

Fifty replicas of his original book were donated to four bird conservation groups to raise money for their organizations. In addition to the AFA, replicas were also donated to the World Parrot Trust, Loro Parque, and Parrots International (California), all of which are dedicated to avian education and preservation.

The auction took place during the AFA's 39th Annual Convention held on August 7 to 10, 2013, in Raleigh, North Carolina.
